When and where?

Scouts to Rovers: 7:30am to 2:00pm (4-hour rogaine)
Joeys and Cubs: 9:30am to 2:00pm (2-hour rogaine)

Changing Mountain Bushland (Lake Manchester Road, Kholo)

Who can participate?



2-hour rogaine in teams of 2–4 youth plus one Leader.

4-hour rogaine in teams of 3–5 youth on their own.

How much?

Free for Leaders (and Rover staff)

What is rogaining?

Rogaining is a sport of long-distance cross-country navigation, a bit like orienteering. Here's a quick comparison:

Orienteering

- Set course to follow →
- Follow route in order →
- Race for quickest time →
- All checkpoints equal →

Rogaining

- Set duration for event
- Choose your own route
- Race for maximum points
- Harder checkpoints = higher points

Rogaining features a combination of teamwork, strategy and map reading, as teams try to get the most points to win.
